Changing your password

To change your password once logged in and in Admin View, click on the blue 'Support' button in the lower right, type in Change Password in the popup box and hit Enter. Click on '1. Passwords' on the list and then select 'Changing the password by a contact' on the next list. Follow the instructions, as below:

Changing the password by a contact

A member or other contact can change their password by clicking the **Change password** link that appears below or beside the link to their profile after the member logs in.



On the screen that appears, the contact enters their current password, then the new password, and the new password again for confirmation.
